Renee Focht who is a Postal Inspector and Public Information Officer gave the usual updated speech on all the scams by mail and other means to lighten your wallet.

Renee has been with the department for 13 years as an inspector, prior to that she carried the mail for 17 years. She has received many commendations for the Federal Investigations she has conducted.

Some things you might not know are the US Postal Inspection Service is the oldest law enforcement agency in the United States.

The FBI has jurisdiction over wire fraud. Mail from within the US can not be opened and inspected. Mail from outside of the US can be opened. Mail Fraud is a Federal offense and punishable with a 20 year minimum sentence.

Some of the things that Renee deals with is Mail Theft, Identity Theft, Ponzi Schemes, False Change of Address on-line, ID Theft, Reshipping Scams, Money Order Scams, Internet Scams, Dialing for Dollars, Sweepstakes, and Victim Rights.

By the way, I did not have the opportunity to see her badge and gun but I assumed she had them.
