"My daughter Shelby has skydived before gave me the jump for as a birthday present in May. I decided to use it last weekend. We went to Skydive San Diego, which is located east of San Diego adjacent to Otay Lakes, 7 miles north of Mexico. This is a very nice facility and they have an excellent safety record.

The experience was exciting, the views are outstanding, you exit the airplane at 13,000 feet, free fall at 100-125 miles per hour for about 1 minute (5 seconds per 1,000 ft.), the parachute deploys at 5,500 feet, and you land gently in a field at the jump facility. Of course the first jump is tandem, harnessed to an instructor.

This is something I have always wanted to do and just haven't gotten around to it. It was so exhilarating and fun that I will definitely do it again. I would highly recommend it to others."
