**THIS TUESDAY**

Criminal defense attorney, John Tyre will talk about the death penalty in California. Capital punishment is a legal form of punishment in the U.S. state of California. The first recorded execution in the area that is now California was on April 11, 1778 when four Native Americans were shot in San Diego County for conspiracy to commit murder. These were the first of 709 executions before the Furman v. Georgia decision of the United States Supreme Court. Since 1976, 13 people have been executed by the state. As of October 21, 2007 there are 667 people on "Death Row".
